# MEMORANDUM

### 20<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Heads of European State Mining Authorities

Dublin, Ireland 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> of October 2014

We, the representatives of European State Mining Authorities, signed overleaf, have been pleased to accept the invitation of Ireland to attend the 20<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Heads of European State Mining Authorities in Dublin, which focused on sharing the lessons learned from significant mining incidents, we unanimously proclaim that:

- 1. The 20<sup>th</sup> Meeting has contributed to the exchange of knowledge, information and experiences about significant mining incidents and the mines rescue capabilities in a number of represented countries.
- 2. The 20<sup>th</sup> Meeting has identified the benefits of sharing knowledge, information and experiences of significant mining incidents to all members of European State Mining Authorities in a prompt and effective manner.
- 3. The 20<sup>th</sup> Meeting has identified the benefits of sharing information on Mines Rescue Services, Mines Rescue Equipment and major deployments of mines rescue personnel to attend to incidents and the outcomes of such intervention.
- 4. The 20<sup>th</sup> Meeting has agreed the use of the two pro-forma attached as Appendix A and B to notify members of European State Mining Authorities in relation to points 2 and 3 above.
- 5. There is to continue cooperation between the European State Mining Authorities concerning both mutually important specific topics and also general topics of current interest including mutual assistance in all matters including emergency response preparedness, while avoiding duplication of activities of other European bodies.
- 6. Future meetings will review a summary of notification of incidents that have arisen following each meeting

We are pleased to accept the invitation from Finland to host the 21<sup>st</sup> Meeting of the Heads of European State Mining Authorities in 2015 on the topic of the social acceptability of mining activities
