

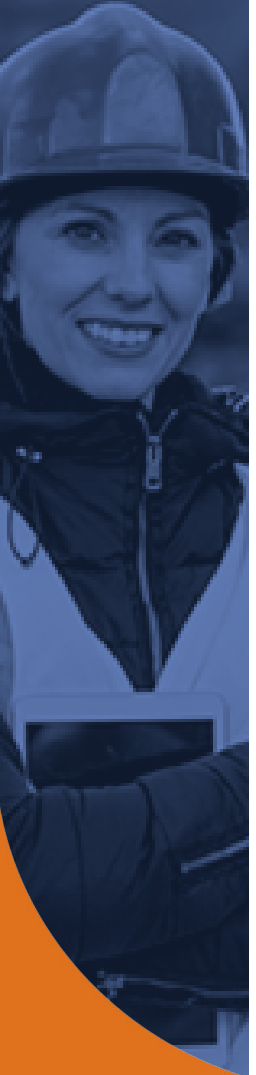

Conclusions

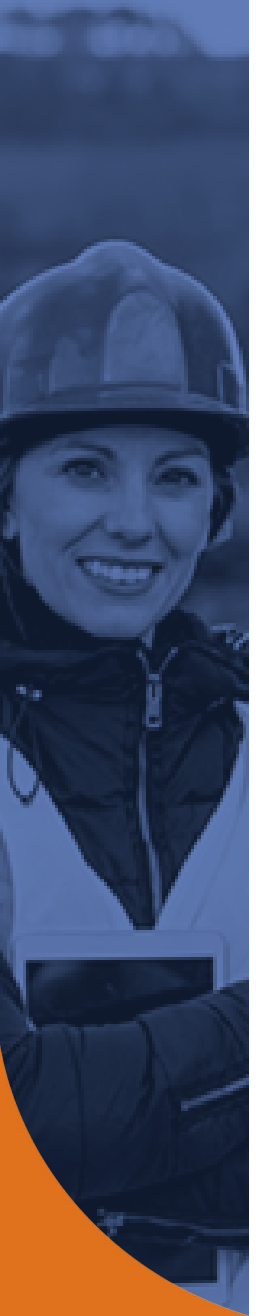
- Enhanced protection of human health and the environment through the new hazard classes
- Comprehensive criteria for identifying and classifying substances in the new hazard classes
- Guidance in place to help you understand how to classify a substance
 - iterative process
 - will be updated when more experience gained
- Continuous improvement and increasing knowledge
- Guidance and support available

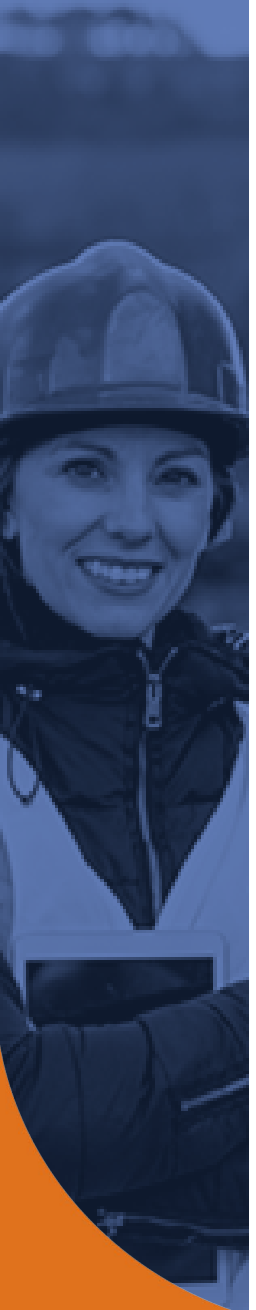


Take Home Messages

- **Review** your portfolio of substances and mixtures
- **Be aware** of the transitional arrangements
- **Become familiar** with the ECHA guidance
- **Get ready** to apply the new hazard classes, as relevant
- Can **already include** them in REACH registrations, poison centre notifications, C&L notifications, etc.

Remember! At the end of the transition period, it will be mandatory to indicate if a substance is classified in any of the new hazard classes
