- Section 54(2) Defect owner knows of OR could have discovered by the exercise of ordinary care.
- Section 103(4) Owner's duty to disclose driver at time of alleged fixed charge offence
- Section 107(4) Owner's duty to disclose driver at time of alleged offence.
