

**What are the health and safety requirements for Graders? (**

<b>Other precautions:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Speed of operation must be adjusted to suit the site and job conditions</li> <li>• Other road users should be alerted to the fact that the grader is in operation, particularly as much of a graders working cycle is spent in reverse.</li> <li>• If working on sloping ground or near excavation edges, facilities such as front wheel lean, articulated steering or wheel offset steering should be used with caution</li> <li>• If the grader is working on a road used by other traffic, clearance flags should be fitted on the blade, lights and warning signs such as 'slow moving vehicle' may also be required</li> <li>• When working near the outer edge of a side hill road, the blade should be extended towards the hazard</li> <li>• When scarifying across a slope the blade should be positioned across the machine to provide some protection against overturning</li> <li>• Appropriate PPE should be given to the driver</li> <li>• Drivers cabins should be suitable to protect from adverse weather conditions</li> <li>• All vehicles should be inspected by the driver at the start of the shift</li> </ul> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>This list is not exhaustive</i></p>
